SEASON OVERVIEW

Players/Parents must register in person and must provide the original copy of the player's birth certificate or other legal proof of age, a wallet size photo of the player to be registered (photo will not be returned) and the \$45.00 fee (cash, checks or money orders only). Players must be at least 3 years old before August 1, 2011.

Scheduled open Registration dates are detailed above. Registrations CANNOT be taken by phone and payment by credit card cannot be accepted.

The registration deadline is Tuesday the 23rd day of August. A **\$20.00 late fee per player** will be charged for registrations received after this date. Absolutely NO registrations will be accepted after August 23rd. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

Players should receive a call from the team coach notifying the date and time and location of their first practice within a week from the required Coaches meeting. The Coaches meetings will be scheduled with Dustin Denio. U10 to U13 draft is scheduled for August 27th at "Cielo Grande Complex", Games begin September 24th and end November 12th. The Annual General Meeting is scheduled for 2:00 PM on November 12th this is where **board members are elected and policy changes are voted on** at the Cielo Grande. Trophies will be given to the coaches for each player on the team. The coach must turn in the Coach Book and Player Cards.

Items Needed for Registration:

1. Original copy of the **player's birth certificate** or other accepted legal proof of age.
2. A **wallet size photo** the registering player.
3. A cash, check or money order for **\$45.00 per player.**
4. Completed Registration **Application** (available at registration)

TEAM ROSTERS

Annually in the fall, players are assigned to teams by the school district the player attends. If there are more players in a particular school district than a team can accommodate, then those players are assigned as possible to a team in the proximate school district. In the spring, the team rosters remain the same as the fall. For the teams which disband, the players will be reassigned to teams using the same parameters. U10 and U13 teams will be decided with a draft format. Draft will be August 27th.

UNIFORMS / JERSEYS

RYSA requires a red / blue reversible jersey. Jerseys will be for sale for \$15.00 at the Cielo Grande Concession during all registration days or on game days. Other equipment such as shorts, shin guards, socks and soccer cleats can be purchased at your local vendor.

The recognition program "Pursuing Victory with Honor" is the national Character Counts! theme for good sportsmanship in athletics. Nominated by their coaches, soccer Athletes of Character (one from each team whose coach has completed training) and soccer Coaches of Character (selected by the RYSA board) will be honored at the conclusion of the season.

For RYSA coaches to be eligible to identify athletes and receive recognition they will need to complete the Pursuing Victory With Honor / Positive Coaching Alliance interactive CD-ROM training seminar presented by **CC!CC**, giving local coaches direction in appropriately coaching young people. Once this interactive CD-ROM training is completed, a coach has completed **CC!CC's** requirements.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

To help us make this season even more successful than last we want to remind all parents, coaches and players of the following...

- 1) Players socks must completely cover the shin guards
- 2) No earrings, necklaces or other jewelry. No sharp objects on the players head or body.
- 3) No toe cleats are to be on shoes worn in this league. If a player is found by the referee to have them – they will be cut off or the player asked to leave the field. (This is a safety issue for the other players on the field)
- 4) ALL parents, relatives, and supporters need to be located on the opposite side of the field from the players and coaches who are positioned on the side of the field with orange cones at mid-field. No one is allowed in the end zone areas of the field. Only the players, coaches & assistant coaches (*who must be issued a coach card by the registrar*) are allowed on the team side of the field. This is a safety concern and is to protect players as coaches have undergone a background check.
- 5) Serious injuries are possible when a child or children hang on a goal causing the goal to fall and injure a child. Please inform players of this serious danger and assist the RYSA to discourage this activity at all times.
- 6) Pets are never allowed on fields during practice or games.
